



20th ANNUAL DGA STUDENT FILM AWARDS

for Women and Minority Directors



The Directors Guild of America Student Film Awards for African-American, Asian-American, Latino, and Women Directors are designed to honor, encourage, and bring attention to outstanding minority and women students in DGA selected film schools in the Eastern and Western regions. The awards bring prizes of \$2,500 to the winners in each category and \$1,000 to Jury Award winners.

APPLICATION

Eligible student films are those in which every major crew position is held by a student.

Competing films must have been completed in the 2013/2014 school year (September 2013 through August 2014).

Applicants must be enrolled in or be a recent graduate (within one year) from an accredited post-secondary institution located in the United States and selected by the DGA.

Applicants must be the Director of the film. No co-director applicants.

Only films or videos produced as a student project under the supervision of a faculty member are eligible. A supervising faculty member must endorse the applicant's entry form.

Eligible films are dramas, comedies and documentaries. Animated films, experimental films, commercials and music videos are not eligible. No more than 30% of stock footage may be used in documentary films. All music rights must be obtained prior to submission.

Students may submit more than one film, but may not submit the same film to more than one category (African-American, Asian-American, Latino or Women). For example, a woman of color may submit a film to either an ethnic minority category or the women's category or submit films to both categories as long as it is not the same film.

Entries must be on DVD-R and labeled with your name, address, phone number and film title. Please make sure materials can be viewed on a stand-alone DVD player.

Entries should be no longer than 30 minutes in length. For longer films, indicate the appropriate starting place. Only 30 minutes of each submission will be viewed.

ENTRY DEADLINE: All submissions must be received at the Directors Guild National Office in Los Angeles by 6:00 PM on Monday, October 6, 2014.

The winners for each category (African-American, Asian-American, Latino and Women) in each region will be awarded \$2,500 by the DGA. A Jury Award (Honorable Mention) in each region will be awarded \$1,000. At the discretion of each committee, awards may not be granted.

Winners must submit their same completed film in its final format for screening at the Awards ceremony. 30 minutes of all Award-winning films will be screened.

The Awards ceremonies will be held at DGA headquarters in Los Angeles and New York on dates TBD.
